



failure to state a claim	4%
frivolous	1%
Corrective Actions (oral counseling, written counseling, training, performance-based action)	35%
Concluded (e.g., retirement, resignation, termination)	6%
Discipline (reprimand, suspension)	5%
Other (resolved per another complaint, decision reversed)	11%
