PETITION FOR IMMEDIATE SUSPENSION

On November 17, 2016, the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court of the State of New York, Third Judicial Department suspended the respondent from the practice of law in New York for 6 months. The respondent's suspension was based upon her suspension in Virginia, and her failure to comply with all the conditions of an April, 2015, censure by the New York court, concerning an immigration client. On October 19, 2017, the Disciplinary Counsel for the Department of Homeland Security ("DHS") petitioned for the respondent's immediate suspension from practice before that agency. The Disciplinary Counsel for the DHS presents evidence that the respondent remains suspended from the practice of law in New York, as of the date of its filing. The Disciplinary Counsel for the Executive Office for Immigration Review asks that the respondent be similarly suspended from practice before the Board of Immigration Appeals ("Board") and the Immigration Courts. The petition will be granted. *See* 8 C.F.R. § 1003.103(a)(4) (2017).<sup>1</sup>

ORDER: The petition is granted, and the respondent is hereby suspended from the practice of law before the Board, the Immigration Courts, and the DHS pending final disposition of this proceeding. 8 C.F.R. § 1003.103(a)(4).

FURTHER ORDER: The respondent shall promptly notify, in writing, any clients with cases currently pending before the Board, the Immigration Courts, or the DHS that the respondent has been suspended from practicing before these bodies.

FURTHER ORDER: The respondent shall maintain records to evidence compliance with this order.
