## <u>UNITED STATES' MOTION FOR REDUCTION</u> OF SENTENCE PURSUANT TO FED. R. CRIM. PRO. 35

Comes now the United States of America, by and through its undersigned attorney, and files its Motion for Reduction of Sentence under the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure Rule 35.

1.
