

ICITAP Contributes to Colombian National Police Anti-Corruption Campaign

On August 14, 2003, the Colombian National Police (CNP) launched a nationwide CNP anti-corruption campaign, which ICITAP helped develop, called Armese de Valor. The campaign will educate both the public and CNP members on police values, ethics, and respect for human rights, through such media as radio spots, pamphlets, posters, and public appearances. ICITAP was a member of the pre-campaign working group, led by the CNP Office of the Inspector General. ICITAP supported the campaign, through the development of an anti-corruption training course, which, on July 29-31, was presented to 75 CNP officers and staff. Training topics included: police ethics, tendencies of corruption, unexplained wealth, investigative tools, judicial proofs, and hypothetical corruption cases. ICITAP also donated educational materials, which will be used throughout the campaign.
