<u>ORDER</u>

Pending before the Court is a motion filed by the Defendant for continuance of the February 2, 2009, trial setting. In accordance with 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(8)(A), the basis for the continuance is the finding that the ends of justice served in granting such continuance outweigh the best interest of the public and the Defendant in a speedy trial.

The Court finds that pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(8)(B), a failure to grant continuance in this case would deny counsel for the Defendant the reasonable time necessary for effective preparation taking into account the exercise of due diligence and would thereby result in a miscarriage of justice for the Defendant given the pending petitions for writ of certiorari before the Supreme Court.
