On October 11, 1989, I issued an Order for Civil Money Penalty for Paperwork Violations.

The caption of the Order which reads ``Order for Civil Money Penalty for Paperwork Violations'' is changed to read ``Decision and Order for Civil Money Penalty for Paperwork Violations.''

On page 14, the following paragraph is added after the first paragraph to read as follows:

That pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1324a(e)(7), and as provided at 28 C.F.R. § 68.52, this Decision and Order shall become the final Decision and Order of the Attorney General, unless within thirty (30) days from the date of October 11, 1989, it shall have been modified or vacated by the Chief Administrative Hearing Officer.
