SW WASHINGTON FUGITIVE ROUND-UP A SUCCESS *Federal, State, and Local resources band together for local effort*

Local jails are full after a week-long fugitive round-up took place in Clark and Cowlitz Counties. While most of the arrests took place in Washington state, several leads took investigators to Washington and Multnomah counties in Oregon. In all, 59 arrests were made and 139 felony warrants were cleared as a result of the effort.

Supported by the U.S. Marshals Service hosted Pacific Northwest Fugitive Apprehension Task Force (PNWFAT), deputy sheriffs from Clark and Cowlitz counties, officers from Vancouver, Longview and Kelso Police Departments, special agents from the DEA and FBI, and deputy U.S. marshals from Washington, Oregon and the Marshals' Technical Operations Group descended on the area beginning Monday. The PNWFAT is a U.S. Marshals-sponsored partnership comprised of investigators from the King County Sheriffs Office, Seattle Police Department, Washington State Department of Corrections, Washington State Patrol and the U.S. Marshals Service.

The Task Force is supported by the Project Safe Neighborhoods Initiative and was formed to concentrate apprehension efforts to remove federal, state and local fugitives from the streets. The Task Force objective is to disrupt illegal gun and drug traffickers in the Pacific Northwest and to reduce the amount of violence in the region.

This fugitive round-up is the first of several initiatives for Western Washington. Over 250 fugitives were identified as targets for apprehension, focusing on Cowlitz and Clark county felony warrants. Investigators prioritized them, starting with the "worst of the worst," and worked their way down the list, arresting as many as possible during the five day operation. In addition to the local warrants, several federal fugitives were located and arrested during the course of the investigations.

Significant Arrest Summaries

Vallejo, Joseph R

On June 17, 2004, Joseph Raymond Vallejo, was arrested in Beaverton, Oregon by members of the Pacific Northwest Fugitive Apprehension Task Force (PNWFAT), U.S. Marshals Service, Vancouver Police Department and the DEA. Vallejo was wanted by the Vancouver, WA Police Department, for three counts of armed robbery in the first degree, firearms, narcotics, and theft charges stemming from several home invasion robberies. Vallejo's criminal history includes multiple felony convictions for firearms and narcotics violations. Vallejo was also wanted by the Multnomah County, Oregon Sheriff's Office for escaping from a courtroom in September of 2003, after being arrested for the Vancouver, WA charges.

Mackowiak, Andrea

On June 16, 2004, Andrea Mackowiak was arrested in Vancouver, Washington by members of the Pacific Northwest Fugitive Apprehension Task Force (PNWFAT), Clark County Sheriff's Office, Washington State Department of Corrections and the FBI. Mackowiak was wanted by the Clark County Sheriff's Office and the Washington State Department of Correction for a Probation Violation on an original charge of Possession of Methamphetamine. At the time of her arrest, Mackowiak was found with a loaded firearm and quantities of methamphetamine. Mackowiak has an extensive criminal history including assault, narcotics violations, and obstruction of a police officer.

Significant Arrest Summaries

Clarke, Michael C

On June 16, 2004, elements of the Cowlitz County Sheriffs Office, the Longview Police Department and the Pacific Northwest Fugitive Apprehension Task Force (PNWFAT) arrested Michael Curtis Clarke II at a residence in Longview. The 24 year old was wanted by Cowlitz County for numerous violent charges including Kidnaping, Assault, and Unlawful Imprisonment. When task force members surrounded Clarke's residence to serve the warrants, Clarke refused to answer the door. Task force members made entry, eventually arresting Clarke, without further incident. Also found in the residence were Clarke's girlfriend, a young child and a loaded semi-automatic pistol and shotgun,. No one was hurt in the apprehension and Clarke was booked into Cowlitz County Jail. Longview Police seized the weapons and filed charges for Felon in Possession of a Weapon in addition to those already pending.

Hill, Michele M.

On June 16, 2004, members of the Longview Police Department, Department of Corrections, and the Pacific Northwest Fugitive Apprehension Task Force (PNWFAT) arrested Michele M. Hill. Hill, who is 47 years old, was wanted by the Department of Corrections on Escape charges. Hill's original charge was violation of the uniformed controlled substances act. Hill was staying at the Townhouse Motel, 744 Washington Way, Longview, WA. and was stopped in her vehicle a short distance from the motel. A subsequent search of her vehicle yielded quantities of cocaine and heroin and scales and packaging materials. A search of Hill's motel room resulted in additional quantities of cocaine and more weighing and packaging materials. Hill is facing additional charges of Possession of Cocaine with Intent to Distribute, and Possession of Heroin with Intent to Distribute. Hill was booked into the Cowlitz County Jail.
