EOIR to Close York Immigration Court

FALLS CHURCH, VA – The Executive Office for Immigration Review (EOIR) today announced the forced closing of the York Immigration Court following notice that the lease between the federal government and the prison will expire. The agency will cease holding hearings out of the physical space located within the York County (Pennsylvania) Prison effective at close of business on July 30, 2021.

All pending cases for respondents in custody at the time of the closure will be transferred to another location, and parties will receive notice of such transfer. Please note that all pleadings, including motions, and other correspondence for cases currently assigned to the York Immigration Court should be filed with the location to which the case is transferred beginning Aug. 2, 2021. EOIR recommends including the notation, "Attention – Former York Immigration Court case" on the first page of any such filing.
