Stewart-

As I mentioned in the staff meeting, Chris and I are hoping to meet with Stephen Boyd in the coming weeks regarding the Spokane Tribe Equitable Compensation Act (S. 995), that just passed as amended (removing the one-time back payment) through the Senate Committee on Indian Affairs. While it is not technically a settlement, Chairman Bishop in the House still requires us to go through his settlement steps with DOJ and DOI to make sure it is ok to be passed/signed into law (Bishop letter outlining requirements: https://naturalresources.house.gov/uploadedfiles/04.27.17 ltr to ag \_sessions and secretary zinke re indian water rights s....pdf).

Chris and I are hoping to meet with the Assistant Attorney General to begin the edification and process to ensure that DOJ has the same response as the last Administration, that this is not their jurisdiction as it is not an active settlement claim, and so it is up to DOI. That has been DOJ's response the last couple of congresses.
