DRUG DEALER PLEADS GUILTY TO COCAINE CONSPIRACY

MOBILE, AL-- Brian Perry, of Mobile, pled guilty to conspiracy to possess with intent to distribute cocaine, United States Attorney Deborah J. Rhodes of the Southern District of Alabama announced today.

Perry admitted his involvement with 20 kilograms of cocaine and 750 kilograms of marijuana.

Sentencing in Perry's case was set for June 5, 2008, before United States District Judge Ginny Granade. Perry faces a mandatory minimum sentence of 10 years imprisonment up to a maximum possible penalty of life without parole and a \$4,000,000 fine.

The case was investigated by the Mobile Sheriff's Department, the Mobile Police Department and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The case is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Deborah Griffin.
