SAN CARLOS MAN SENTENCED TO 14 YEARS IN FEDERAL PRISON FOR ATTEMPTED SEXUAL ASSAULT

PHOENIX – Shawn Dillon, of San Carlos, Ariz., was sentenced here by U.S. District Judge Roslyn O. Silver to 14 years in federal prison, followed by lifetime supervised release. On September 28, 2007, Dillon pleaded guilty to Attempted Sexual Assault and admitted to violating the terms of supervised release imposed after a prior sexual assault conviction and prison sentence for a 1997 sexual assault.

In the 2007 case, Dillon did not know his 16-year-old victim but had knocked on her door and asked for her father. When told he was not there, he followed the victim inside the home and forced her into a bedroom, where he attempted to sexually assault her. Her sister came home and witnessed the attempted sexual assault. Dillon ran from the home and was cornered by the sister's boyfriend until the police arrived and arrested him.

The investigation in this case was conducted by the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the San Carlos Police Department. The prosecution was handled by Dyanne C. Greer, Assistant U.S. Attorney, District of Arizona, Phoenix.
