## **ILLEGAL RE-ENTRANT SENTENCED TO NEARLY 5 YEARS IN FEDERAL PRISON**

TUCSON, Ariz. – Carlos Guzman-Ayala, 42, of Ciudad Juarez, Chihuahua, Mexico, was sentenced today by U.S. District Judge Cindy K. Jorgenson to 57 months in federal prison. Guzman-Ayala pleaded guilty on October 21, 2008, to Illegal Re-entry after Deportation.

Guzman-Ayala was sentenced to 57 months in federal prison based, in part, on his prior criminal history which included aggravated felony convictions. The defendant was serving a 36-month term of supervised release when he was arrested on the current charge.

The investigation in this case was conducted by U.S. Border Patrol. The prosecution was handled by Munish Sharda, Assistant U.S. Attorney, District of Arizona, Tucson.
