INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT ONE: (18 U.S.C. § 2113(a) – Bank Robbery)

On or about May 29, 2004, in the Northern District of California, the defendant

JOHN MARK FELDER

did knowingly, and by force, violence, and intimidation, take from the persons and presence of employees of Citibank, 2000 Shattuck Avenue, Berkeley, California, approximately \$20,184.00 in money belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of this Citibank, the deposits of which were then insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

1 COUNT TWO: (18 U.S.C. § 2113(a) – Bank Robbery)

2 On or about June 9, 2004, in the Northern District of California, the defendant

3 JOHN MARK FELDER

4 did knowingly, and by force, violence, and intimidation, take from the persons and presence of employees
5 of Wells Fargo Bank, 5191 Mowry Avenue, Fremont, California, approximately \$9647.00 in money
6 belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of this Wells Fargo Bank, the
7 deposits of which were then insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, in violation of Title 18,
8 United States Code, Section 2113(a).

9 COUNT THREE: (18 U.S.C. § 2113(a) – Bank Robbery)

10 On or about June 9, 2004, in the Northern District of California, the defendant

11 JOHN MARK FELDER

12 did knowingly, and by force, violence, and intimidation, take from the persons and presence of employees
13 of Citibank at 1800 Decoto Road in Union City, California, approximately \$4637.00 in money belonging
14 to and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of this Citibank, the deposits of which
15 were then insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, in violation of Title 18, United States
16 Code, Section 2113(a).

17 COUNT FOUR: (18 U.S.C. § 2113(a) – Bank Robbery)

18 On or about June 19, 2004, in the Northern District of California, the defendant

19 JOHN MARK FELDER

20 did knowingly, and by force, violence, and intimidation, take from the persons and presence of employees
21 of the Washington Mutual Bank, 1870 Solano Avenue, Berkeley, California, approximately \$1,906.00 in
22 money belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of this Washington
23 Mutual Bank, the deposits of which were then insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, in
24 violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

25 COUNT FIVE: (18 U.S.C. § 2113(a) – Bank Robbery)

26 On or about July 12, 2004, in the Northern District of California, the defendant

27 JOHN MARK FELDER

28 did knowingly, and by force, violence, and intimidation, take from the persons and presence of employees

1 of the World Savings Bank, 3348 Lakeshore Drive, Oakland, California, approximately \$814.00 in money
2 belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of this World Savings Bank,
3 the deposits of which were then insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, in violation of Title
4 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

5 SENTENCING ALLEGATIONS

6 With respect to each and every COUNT in this INDICTMENT, with which the
7 defendant, JOHN MARK FELDER, is charged:


- 8 a. The defendant, JOHN MARK FELDER, committed the instant offense while
