COUNT 1

The Grand Jury charges that:


On or about July 27, 2003, in the State and District of Colorado, JOHN WILLIAM ROCHE, the Defendant herein, did transmit in interstate commerce, namely, from the State of Iowa to Eagle County, Colorado, a communication containing a threat to injure the person of another. More specifically, on the aforesaid date, JOHN WILLIAM ROCHE, caused a verbal communication to be transmitted by telephone in Iowa to the telephone answering machine of another in Eagle, Colorado, which was located in the home of a witness in a criminal case captioned *The People of the State of Colorado v. Kobe Bean Bryant*, case number 03CR204, stating in part:

"I'll f-----g stick a coat hanger up your"

"I'll f-----g kill you. I'll kill you you f-----g bitch."


The foregoing was a violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 875(c).
