The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

A. AT ALL TIMES MATERIAL HEREIN:

The Tangipahoa United States Post Office was located at 70136 East Railroad Avenue, Tangipahoa, Louisiana 70465.

B. THE OFFENSE:

On or about March 20, 2008, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **CICERO LOMONT MYERS**, did assault an employee of the Tangipahoa United States Post Office, that is the postal clerk designated as the “Officer in Charge,” having lawful charge, custody and control of United States mail matter, money and other property of the United States, with intent to rob, steal and purloin said mail matter, money and other property of the United States, and in doing so the defendant, **CICERO LOMONT MYERS**, put the life of said postal employee victim in jeopardy

by the use of a dangerous weapon, that is a knife; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code,
Sections 2114(a).
