The Economic Crimes Unit is responsible for investigating and prosecuting sophisticated white collar crimes, including securities fraud, computer hacking, intellectual property crimes, tax fraud, telemarketing fraud, bankruptcy fraud, environmental crimes, and other financial fraud cases..

Responsibilities and Opportunity Offered: The incumbent will manage a group of attorneys and support staff; decide which cases should be investigated and prosecuted; oversee investigative strategy, charging, and disposition decisions, and courtroom practice; assign cases; select and develop staff.

Qualifications:

Required qualifications: Applicants must possess a J.D. degree, be an active member of the bar (any jurisdiction), and have at least 5 years post-J.D. experience.

Preferred qualifications: The ideal candidate will have significant federal trial experience, including 5+ years of prosecutorial experience with required knowledge of grand jury practice, and mail/wire fraud and securities fraud statutes. Proven experience managing a group of attorneys is also preferred.

Travel: Minimal travel is required.

Salary Information: Assistant United States Attorneys' pay is administratively determined based, in part, on the number years of professional attorney experience. The range of pay is for this position is \$100,000 to \$136,800 including locality pay .
