MEXICO NATIONAL INDICTED FOR ILLEGALLY RE-ENTERING THE U.S.

SPRINGFIELD, Mo. – Todd P. Graves, United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri, announced that a Mexico national was indicted by a federal grand jury today for illegally re-entering the United States.

Juan Roldan-Castillo, 30, a citizen of Mexico, was charged in an indictment returned by a federal grand jury in Springfield.

The federal indictment alleges that **Roldan-Castillo** was found in Texas County, Mo., on April 2, 2004, after previously having been deported from the United States.

Graves cautioned that the charge contained in the indictment is simply an accusation, and not evidence of guilt. Evidence supporting the charge must be presented to a federal trial jury, whose duty is to determine guilt or innocence.

This case was investigated by the Bureau of Immigration and Customs Enforcement.
