INFORMATION

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

1. At all times relevant to this Information:

a. Defendant ANTHONY LUKOWIAK was employed as the Manager of the Newark Division of Sanitation ("Newark DOS"). As the Manager of the Newark DOS, defendant ANTHONY LUKOWIAK was responsible for, among other things, the supervision and management of the collection of garbage for the City of Newark.

b. Co-schemer (the "Contractor") was the primary operator of a waste removal business based in East Newark, New Jersey (the "Waste Company"). The Waste Company had contracts with the Newark DOS for, among other things, the collection of garbage.

c. The Newark DOS was a local government agency that received federal assistance in excess of \$10,000, during the relevant one-year period.

2. From in or about January 2005, to in or about December 2005, in Essex County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, defendant

ANTHONY LUKOWIAK

did knowingly, willfully, and corruptly accept and agree to accept things of value, namely approximately \$24,000 in cash from the Contractor, with intent to be influenced and rewarded in connection with a business, transaction, and series of transactions of the Newark DOS involving a thing of value of \$5,000 and more.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 666(a)(1)(B) and 2.
