COUNT ONE

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:

At all times relevant to this Information:

1. Defendant EDWARD GABRIEL was employed by the General Services Administration as a custodian.

On or about July 24, 2002, at Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

EDWARD GABRIEL

embezzled, stole, purloined, and knowingly converted to his own use a thing of value of the United States in an amount less than \$1,000, that is, an IBM laptop computer, which computer had come into the possession and under the care of defendant EDWARD GABRIEL by virtue of his employment as a custodian in the United States District

Courthouse.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 641.
