**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 21, 2002, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,  
defendant

**JOSEPH PAVELIC**

knowingly and unlawfully, by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Sovereign Bank, located at 1917 East MacDade Boulevard, Folsom, Pennsylvania, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$2,403.00 belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the Sovereign Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, Certificate No. 29950-2 .

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

**COUNT TWO**

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 24, 2002, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,  
defendant

**JOSEPH PAVELIC**

knowingly and unlawfully, by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Commerce Bank, located at 2751 Street Road, Bensalem, Pennsylvania, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$2,717.00 belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the Commerce Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, Certificate No. 252930. .

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

**COUNT THREE**

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 26, 2002, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,  
defendant

**JOSEPH PAVELIC**

knowingly and unlawfully, by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the First Union Bank, located at 9101 Roosevelt Boulevard, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$6,168.00 belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the First Union Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, Certificate No. 338699. .

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

**COUNT FOUR**

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 30, 2002, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,  
defendant

**JOSEPH PAVELIC**

knowingly and unlawfully, by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Commerce Bank, located at 2653 South 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$6,825.00 belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the Commerce Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, Certificate No. 25293-0 .

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).
