**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

On or about August 7, 2003, at Fairless Hills, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**GREGORY MICHAEL BINGAMAN**

did knowingly and unlawfully, by force and violence, and by intimidation, take from employees of the Commerce Bank, 624 South Oxford Valley Road, Fairless Hills, Pennsylvania, money, that is, approximately \$2,170.00 in currency of the United States, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the Commerce Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).
