**COUNT ONE**

**THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:**

On or about June 4, 2003, at Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,  
the defendant

**ANDRE PAUL DAVIS,**

an alien who was previously deported from the United States on or about September 15, 1995,  
was found in the United States, having knowingly and unlawfully re-entered the United States  
without first applying to the United States Attorney General or his successor, the Secretary for  
Homeland Security (Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), (4) and 557), for permission to  
reapply for admission, and without receiving in response the express consent of the Attorney  
General or his successor to reapply for admission.

In violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a) and (b)(2).

## **NOTICE OF PRIOR CONVICTION**

Defendant ANDRE PAUL DAVIS committed the offense charged in Count 1 of this Information after having been convicted in Queens County, New York, of two aggravated felonies, that is, possession of narcotic drugs with intent to sell in violation of 18 New York Code, § 220.16, and tampering with a witness, in violation of 18 New York Code, § 215.11.
