THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:

On or about October 15, 2002, while in the territorial jurisdiction of the United States, at Valley Forge National Historical Park, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

NEVIN CARL CLEMMER,

corrupted, or attempted to corrupt, the morals of a minor, that is, being over the age of 18, enticed and encouraged a minor child, age 15, to engage in the commission of a crime, that is, deviate sexual intercourse, in violation of Title 18, PaC.S.A. § 6301, as assimilated through 18 U.S.C. § 13.
