**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

On or about January 13, 2003, at Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**JOSE ROMERO-MAGANA,**

an alien, who had been deported and removed from the United States on or about December 15, 1997 and August 4, 2001, was found in the United States, without first applying to the United States Attorney General for permission to reapply for admission, and without receiving in response the express consent of the Attorney General to reapply for readmission.

In violation of Title 8, United States Code, Sections 1326(a) and (b)(1).

**NOTICE OF PRIOR CONVICTION**

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

The defendant committed the offense charged in Count One of this Indictment after having been convicted of an offense that is a felony crime subject to the enhanced penalties of 8 U.S.C. § 1326(b)(1) as follows:

On or about November 5, 1997, in the State of Michigan, the defendant was sentenced to term of imprisonment of 155 days following his conviction for carrying a concealed weapon, a felony under the laws of the State of Michigan.
