INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about July 12, 2002, at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, in the Eastern District
of Pennsylvania, defendant

ANWAR ROUNDTREE

knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute a mixture or substance containing a
detectable amount of cocaine, a Schedule II controlled substance.

**In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and
841(b)(1)(C).**

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about July 12, 2002, at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

ANWAR ROUNDTREE

knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine, a Schedule II controlled substance, within 1,000 feet of the real property comprising the Jay Cooke Middle School, a public secondary school, located at 1300 W. Loudon Street in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 860(a).

COUNT THREE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about July 12, 2002, at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

ANWAR ROUNDTREE

knowingly possessed a firearm, that is, a Davis, Model P-380, .380 caliber, semi-automatic handgun, loaded with four rounds of ammunition, including one in the chamber, in furtherance of a drug trafficking crime for which he may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, that is, possession with intent to distribute cocaine, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), and possession with intent to distribute cocaine within 1,000 feet of a secondary school, in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 860(a), as charged in Counts One and Two of this Indictment.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(c).

COUNT FOUR

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or July 12, 2002, at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

ANWAR ROUNDTREE,

having been convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce a firearm, that is, a Davis, Model P-380, .380 caliber semi-automatic handgun, loaded with four rounds of ammunition, including one in the chamber.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1).

NOTICE OF PRIOR CONVICTIONS

Defendant Anwar Roundtree committed the offense charged in Count 1 of this Indictment after having been convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of two felony drug offenses, as follows:

1. Possession with intent to deliver a controlled substance – C.P. Phila. Cty. 9806-0711.
2. Possession with intent to deliver a controlled substance – C.P. Phila. Cty. 9908-0779.

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

As a result of the violations of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(c) set forth in Counts Three and Four of this Indictment, the defendant

ANWAR ROUNDTREE

shall forfeit to the United States of America, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 924(d) and 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c), the firearm and ammunition involved in the commission of these offenses, including, but not limited to:

(1) a Davis, Model P-380, .380 caliber, semi-automatic handgun, loaded with four rounds of ammunition, including 1 in the chamber.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d).
