INFORMATION

COUNT ONE

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:

1. At all times material to this Information, the defendant, CALVIN A. SANDERS, a/k/a "Anthony C. Sanders," was employed by the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) as a Transportation Security Screener (TSS) at the Philadelphia International Airport.

2. At all times material to this Information, the defendant, CALVIN A. SANDERS, a/k/a "Anthony C. Sanders," was simultaneously working the x-ray position and the entry position to Check Point C located at the Philadelphia International Airport.

3. At all times material to this Information, the defendant, CALVIN A. SANDERS, a/k/a "Anthony C. Sanders," was responsible for screening airline passengers and their personal belongings before they were permitted to enter Terminal C at the Philadelphia International Airport.

4. On or about April 6, 2003, at Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

being an officer and employee of the United States and of the Transportation Security Administration (TSA), did knowingly embezzle and wrongfully convert to his own use property of another, that is approximately \$273 in United States currency belonging to an airline passenger entering Terminal C of the Philadelphia International Airport, which currency had come into his possession and under his control in the execution of his employment, and under the color or claim of authority as such officer and employee of the Transportation Security Administration.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 654.
