**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about April 4, 2003, at Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,  
defendant

PAUL ANESTER NOBEL,  
a/k/a "Paul Scott"  
a/k/a "Otis Yates"

an alien, being a citizen of Jamaica, who had previously been deported from the United States on or about August 16, 1995, and was thereafter found in the United States, having knowingly and unlawfully reentered the United States without first applying to the United States Attorney General and the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security for permission to reapply for admission, and without receiving in response the express consent of the Attorney General and the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security to reapply for admission.

In violation of Title 8, United States Code, Sections 1326(a) and (b)(2) and Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202 (3) and (4) and 557.

**NOTICE OF PRIOR CONVICTIONS**

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

Defendant PAUL ANESTER NOBEL, a/k/a “Paul Scott,” a/k/a “Otis Yates” committed the offense charged in Count One of this Indictment after having been convicted of felony drug offenses as follows:

(1) On or about September 1, 1992, in Philadelphia Municipal Court, No. MC9203-3018, the defendant was sentenced following his conviction for manufacture and delivery of a controlled substance, which is a felony under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

(2) On or about March 18, 1993, in Philadelphia Municipal Court, No. MC9212-2158, the defendant was sentenced following his conviction for manufacture and delivery of a controlled substance, which is a felony under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
