**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about April 10, 2003, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, the defendant

LINO ANDRES AMEZQUITA  
a/k/a Andres Nunez,  
a/k/a Rubin Arroyo,  
a/k/a Lino Nunez,

an alien who had previously been deported from the United States on or about August 30, 1996, was found in the United States, having knowingly and unlawfully re-entered the United States without first applying to the Attorney General of the United States or his successor, the Secretary for Homeland Security (Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), (4) and 557), for permission to reapply for admission, and without receiving in response the express consent of the Attorney General or his successor to reapply for admission.

In violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a), (b)(2).

**NOTICE OF PRIOR CONVICTIONS**

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

Defendant LINO ANDRES AMEZQUITA, a/k/a Andres Nunez, Rubin Arroyo, Lino Nunez, committed the offense charged in Count One of this Indictment after having been convicted of the following felony offenses:

(1) On or about October 28, 1994, in the Supreme Court of the State of New York, the defendant was sentenced following his conviction for criminal possession of a forged instrument in the second degree, Indictment Number 8418-94.

(2) On or about October 28, 1994, in the Supreme Court of the State of New York, the defendant was sentenced following his conviction for robbery in the first degree, Indictment Number 6146-93.
