COUNT ONE

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:

On or about May 3, 2003, at Independence National
Historical Park, Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of
Pennsylvania, defendant

BERNARD A. HEINZ

forcibly assaulted, impeded, and interfered with National Park
Service Ranger David E. Hall, while Ranger Hall was engaged in
the performance of his official duties, that is, by striking
Ranger Hall in the face and breaking his nose while Ranger Hall
was attempting to stop a brawl on federal property.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section
111(a)(1).
