INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about January 23, 2004, at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, the defendant,

JAVIER REYES-CEJA,
a/k/a "Javier Reyes-Cejas,"
a/k/a "Javier Reyes-Cijas,"

an alien and a subject of Mexico, who had previously been deported from the United States on or about October 4, 1996, was found in the United States, having knowingly and unlawfully reentered the United States without first applying to the United States Attorney General or his successor, the Secretary for Homeland Security (Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), (4) and 557), for permission to reapply for admission, and without receiving in response the express consent of the Attorney General or his successor to reapply for admission.

In violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a) and (b)(1).
