Madison, Wisconsin -- Erik C. Peterson, United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Jammie Hatcher, 21, of Madison, Wis., was sentenced today by U.S. District Judge Barbara Crabb to 80 months in prison without parole for selling crack cocaine. Hatcher pleaded guilty to this charge on January 13, 2009.

Hatcher sold crack cocaine to an undercover officer in Madison on several occasions. When the home he shared with his girlfriend on Monterey Drive was searched following his arrest, officers found a gun and additional crack cocaine. He was on parole for shooting a person at the time he sold the drugs to the officer.

The charges against Hatcher were the result of an investigation conducted by the Dane County Narcotics and Gang Task Force and the Drug Enforcement Administration. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Elizabeth Altman.
