Madison, Wisconsin -- Erik C. Peterson, United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Theresa L. Alldredge, 42, of Grand Marsh, Wis., was sentenced in U.S. District in Madison yesterday to 15 months in prison and ordered to serve a three-year term of supervised release upon her release from custody.

Alldredge had previously plead guilty to possessing and passing counterfeit \$100 Federal Reserve Notes.

At the plea hearing, Alldredge acknowledged that she was arrested by Adams County authorities when she attempted to pay traffic fines and property taxes with \$1,100 in counterfeit United States \$100 Federal Reserve Notes.

The charge against Theresa L. Alldredge were the result of an investigation conducted by the U.S. Secret Service, the Adams County Sheriff's Department, and the Sauk County Sheriff's Department. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Grant C. Johnson.
