Single Audit Information on the Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification

The Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification (ESAC) report contains a new section requiring the jurisdiction's Single Audit information. The jurisdiction will be required to identify the independent auditing firm used by the jurisdiction and the Harvester Database number for the jurisdiction's prior fiscal year's Single Audit. Agencies completing the form should consult with their jurisdiction's finance department to obtain this information.

If the agency's jurisdiction does not meet the threshold requirements to complete a Single Audit and does not have an independent auditor, enter Not Applicable in the Company field and enter Jurisdiction Did Not Meet

Threshold in the Harvester Database field. If the jurisdiction filed a Single Audit but did not include expenditures of equitably shared funds on its Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards, include the auditor's information and select No.
