Personal Protective Equipment for First Responders

The Department of Justice has received inquiries related to equipment purchases to protect first responders in response to COVID-19. The *Guide to Equitable Sharing for State, Local, and Tribal Law Enforcement Agencies* (July 2018), Section V.B.1.e permits the use of federally shared funds for certain joint law enforcement and public safety equipment and operations. Among these uses, agencies may purchase personal protective equipment including masks, gloves, sanitizers, and other gear to be distributed to public safety first responders including police, fire, and emergency medical service employees.
