SENTENCE OR PROBATION ORDER

The court asked whether defendant had anything to say why judgment should not be pronounced. Because no sufficient cause to the contrary was shown, or appeared to the court, the court adjudged the defendant guilty as charged and convicted and ordered that: For defendant is hereby committed to the custody of the Attorney General for a period of

\$750,000.00 fine to be paid within five (5) days.
