INFORMATION

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COUNT 1 (Bribery of a Public Official)

THE UNITED STATES CHARGES THAT:

Between October 2004 and August 2008, the defendant, Afghan International Trucking, directly and indirectly, knowingly and corruptly offered monetary bribe payments to U.S. officials in order to influence the performance of an official act and to aid in a fraud against the United States, to wit: the defendant paid approximately \$190,000 in the Eastern District of Virginia and elsewhere to military officials at the Bagram Airfield in Afghanistan in exchange for fraudulently awarding the defendant government contract work and payment for work that the defendant never performed. In violation of Title 18, United States Code, §§ 201(b)(2)(A) and 201(b)(2)(B).
