I FIND there is no need to conduct a hearing to determine the fairness of the Agreement, and the proposed decision and order, and

I HEREBY FURTHER FIND that said Agreement and the proposed decision and order based thereon are fair, and that the entry of said decision and order would further the interests of justice. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that said Agreement (which is incorporated herein by reference) is hereby approved; that the violations relating to Manuel Ruiz, Joe Alcala, and Rene Camarillo, as charged in the

<u>Complaint</u>, and <u>Amended Complaint</u>, are hereby DISMISSED; that the Orders setting a discovery schedule and filing schedule for proceeding under the Equal Access to Justice Act, and the subsequent Order, modifying said schedules, are hereby rescinded. These proceedings are now CLOSED.
