### COMPONENT PURPOSE / JUSTIFICATION FOR APPROVAL

The conference will highlight and share research, promote best practices, and information between researchers and practitioners in the field. The purpose of the conference is to convene research grantees and practitioner partners to highlight and learn from the research evidence that has been generated from NIJ's investments.
