- A "Certification and Assurance" letter must be submitted on the letterhead of the applicant.
- The Authorized Representative of the applicant must sign the letter.
- The "Authorized Representative" must have the authority to apply for and accept grant awards on behalf of the organization.
- Applicants must ensure that all language in the letter accurately reflects what is required in the solicitation.
- Use of the sample template letter is highly encouraged to the extent possible, assuming that it is true for the applicant.
