To comply with these regulations, we request that you sign an authorization which will allow us to communicate directly with the debtor regarding administrative matters, including but not limited to, insurance coverage, bank account information, monthly operating reports, quarterly fees and post-confirmation reports.

If you agree to direct contacts between the debtor and U.S. Trustee's staff concerning administrative matters, please sign this authorization where indicated and return it to the Office of the United States Trustee at the address indicated below. The authorization may be rescinded at any time by giving us written notice of rescission.

If you do not agree, all communications regarding the debtor will be directed to you. If the debtor initiates any contact with us, we will advise him or her that we may communicate only with you.

If the United States Trustee files or has a contested motion or an adversary proceeding against the debtor, all contact regarding that matter will be with counsel.
