Proof of ID and Social Security Number

Beginning in March, 2002, the United States Trustee will require bankruptcy debtors to provide to the trustee, at the meeting of creditors, satisfactory proof of identity and proof of social security number.

Debtors will need to bring both proof of identity and proof of social security number to the meeting. Acceptable proof is listed below:

A. Proof of Identity: a valid state driver's license, government-issued picture ID card, U.S. passport, government employee photo ID, military photo ID, legal resident alien card, or Mexican consulate card ("matricula consular").

B. Proof of Social Security Number: original Social Security card, Social Security statement, form W-2 for the most recent tax year, recent payroll stub, health card, or other official documentation which indicates name and Social Security number.
